Appendix A – Licence Conditions

Licensee:

A licence holder, who is not an Alberta resident, is required to enter into a contract with the holder of a valid outfitter-guide permit and be accompanied by a designated guide as per regulations.

Before hunting, the licence holder must notify the local Fish and Wildlife Division office of the licence and tag number, intended hunting area within the Wildlife Management Units, and the dates the hunt will occur.

Applicable season:

The Special Licence(s) is **valid** from August 25, 2025, to August 24, 2026, for one male Bighorn Sheep of any horn size or configuration. With exception to horn size configuration, hunting must be in accordance with all provisions of the Wildlife Act and Regulation.

Applicable Area:

This licence is valid in Alberta, in any Wildlife Management Unit where a bighorn sheep hunting season is identified in the 2025 Alberta Guide to Hunting Regulations.

This licence does not authorize hunting in any location where hunting is prohibited as outlined in the *Wildlife Regulation* and the Alberta Guide to Hunting Regulations.

This licence is not valid for resale and is not transferable.

The Minister's Special Licence is an allocated licence as defined in the Wildlife Regulation. Licence must be in hunter's possession while hunting or transporting wildlife and must be produced to an officer upon request.
