

Competitive Fishing Event Licence

Application Form

If you are planning a **Competitive Fishing Event**, which is a fishing event that involves more than 25 anglers and awards prizes based on success, complete and submit this **Application Form** along with copies of the event rules and facility permissions.

A **Competitive Fishing Event Licence** will only be issued to an adult resident of Alberta or to an organization, club, social group, a business incorporated or registered under the Business Corporations Act or Societies Act, respectively.

If you are organizing a **Fishing Event** which involves less than 26 anglers, occurs at one or more waterbodies, register your event using the **Notification Form**.

The Summary Form must be submitted within 14 days of the event ending.

You will receive payment information, after your Competitive Fishing Event application is reviewed.

Note: The organizer of the event must be a resident of Alberta.
