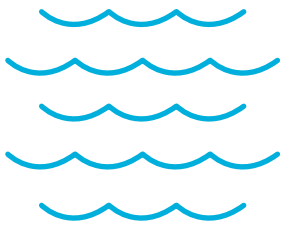


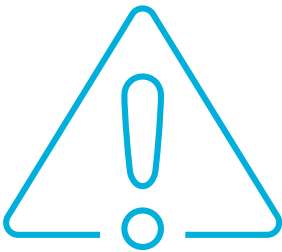
Ice Fishing Safety

Keep yourself, other anglers, Alberta's fish and their habitats safe while ice fishing



AVOID

ice near open water and be extra cautious on river and stream ice.



LOOK

for signage warning of thin or weak ice

NEVER

walk on ice less than

10cm
THICK



NEVER

drive on ice less than

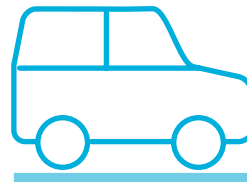
30cm
THICK



Label ice huts and remove on or before March 31st (March 15th in Fisheries Management Area PP1).

DRIVE SLOWLY

KEEP SEATBELTS OFF



OPEN YOUR WINDOW A CRACK

HALF UNLATCH YOUR DOOR FOR QUICK OPENING.

IF YOU FALL THROUGH THE ICE:

- Exit your vehicle immediately.
- Crawl on your belly on the ice, spreading your weight. Use nails or spikes for added traction.
- Find a warm place and dry clothes as quickly as possible!
