

Those wanting to hunt in 1 of the 2 National Wildlife Areas (NWA's) at CFB Suffield:

- 1) You must enter a daily draw in order to hunt one of CFB Suffield's two NWA's (See map on page 2. NWA North is green area, & NWA South is pink area).
- 2) If you are interested in entering the draw, let the person know when they come to your vehicle to register you.
- 3) To enter the draw, your vehicle license plate will be taken down and put into a hat. The draw will occur during the briefing.
- 4) After the briefing is done, those picked will be announced over the radio.
- 5) If you were drawn for the NWA, turn your hazard lights on and/or notify the hunt staff as they walk the lines of vehicles. Let them know if you were drawn for the North or South NWA.
- 6) Once confirmed that you were drawn, you will be issued the NWA paperwork, vehicle pass and bracelet. The NWA bracelet will be the daily colour for hunting in the NWA that you were drawn for.
- 7) Hunters are to keep their weekly hunting bracelets on as well, as they are good for the week in the Main Hunting Area. The NWA bracelet is only good for the day you were drawn. Once through the exit point at the end of the day, the NWA bracelets can & should be removed.
- 8) The rules and regulations for hunting in the NWA at CFB Suffield will be discussed further during your morning brief over the radio.

NOTE:

- The NWA's are **walk in, walk out.**
- **Only certain main roads** can be used. This will be discussed further during the brief.
- Hunters **must** retrieve their elk by foot if in the NWA.
- Cell phone coverage is very poor in the NWA's.
- **Mandatory** items for hunting in the NWA's: 1) satellite GPS, or compass and 2) a flashlight. You will be asked to prove that you have these 2 mandatory items.
- **Only those with an NWA pass can drive on the authorized roads in the NWA! No NWA pass = Fine!**
