

Attention WMU 353 Antlerless Moose Licence Holders

Drawn Applicants –Hunting Information

The Alberta Fish and Wildlife Division is requesting the cooperation of hunters who have been successful in the Wildlife Management Unit 353 Antlerless Moose Draw.

Habitat changes in the western portion of WMU 353 will produce more food for moose and the result will be an increase in moose numbers. Wolves would also likely increase in number and kill more caribou. This would have a detrimental affect on threatened woodland caribou herds. Therefore, our goal is to maintain moose numbers at current levels in the western portion of WMU 353.

The antlerless moose season is open only in the portion of WMU 353 west of Range 23 (see map). Your cooperation is appreciated.

NOTE: The restriction regarding carrying a weapon on an off-highway vehicle during the morning hours was removed in 2008.
